### Feeding Information

Our house brand dog food is Purina One in lamb or chicken recipe. In addition, we have Racheal Ray dry kibble. Our canned wet food is Purina One and we get several different recipes. We recommend that you bring your dog's typical diet to avoid gastrointestinal distress. Sudden food changes can result in stomach upset. With medications and food, please bring enough for your pet's stay plus a few extra in case of emergency, delayed flight, or an extended stay. It is best but not required to pre-measure your dog's food and put it in labeled bags. *we do accept raw/refrigerated diets*
Your dog's regular diet:
